### **INTRODUCTORY FLOTILLA ROUTES**

1 WEEK ROUTES: SOUTH IONIAN HIGHLIGHTS, PAXOS AND **NEW** ARGOLIC GULF FLOTILLAS, 22 & 29 JUNE

2 WEEK: SOUTH IONIAN FLOTILLA

In the Ionian Islands there is minimal tide, swell or compass variation to worry about and you are never more than 10 miles from land. It is the ideal | like a little more sailing and a look around different sailing area for those new to overseas sailing.

If you are looking to test the waters, then our one week flotillas sailing around Paxos and Corfu, or the South Ionian, are a great first step.

They offer the opportunity to sail in the sheltered waters of the Ionian Islands visiting quaint towns and villages along the way.

Our routes are arranged to be sheltered from the prevailing wind. Sometimes there's not enough wind, other times a little too much, but there is always a safe harbour close by and weather forecasting these days is fantastic. You can also combine your time sailing with a week relaxing on shore with one of our 'Villa Flotillas'.

### **OUR NEXT STEP FLOTILLA ROUTES**

2 WEEK ROUTES: WHOLE IONIAN, SOUTH IONIAN, AND

**FARAWAY ISLANDS** 

3 WEEK: 'ONE-OFF' IONIAN HIGHLIGHTS, 18 MAY

. These flotillas tend to appeal to those who have enjoyed one of the easier routes and would now islands, bays and villages.

The Whole Ionian - our flagship flotilla route - covers slightly more miles than the introductory flotillas with one or two longer days. It visits a selection of our favourite stops in both the North and the South Ionian as well as the best bits in between.

This is a one-way route and our most popular flotilla! The Whole Ionian and Faraway Islands routes are still relaxed and simply make for some great sailing.

Our two week South Ionian flotilla explores all the best of this amazing sailing area. You will sail further afield and probably visit bays and harbours which are a little more off the beaten track.

## FLOTILLA ROUTES TO ASPIRE TO

2 WEEK ROUTES: THE ARGOLIC GULF & SARONIC ISLANDS, THE SECLUDED SPORADES ISLAND AREA, AND THE CORINTH CANAL SUMMER CRUISES

Our "slightly more sailing", Saronic and Sporades, flotillas provide a further step along in flotilla sailing, whilst remaining very much a holiday. If you fancy excellent sailing in more open waters, these routes reach beautiful and uncrowded places.

Our Saronic Islands and Coastal Villages of the Argolic Gulf flotilla is a voyage through history with reliable sailing breezes. It visits amazing spots like Spetses, Ermioni, Plaka, and Tiros, depending on which way the wind is blowing.

Our Sporades flotilla is our most open water flotilla, renowned for excellent sailing due to the shelter offered by the islands. This route allows you to really get away from it all as you will likely spend a few nights anchored in bays!

All Two and Three Week flotillas are likely to have two night stops somewhere en route for time to explore, visit historic places or to have a day sail.

# WHAT ARE THEY ALL ABOUT?

To be able to drift around the islands of Greece under sail is a rare pleasure that we are proud to offer. Our holidays concentrate on the most enjoyable aspects of sailing - spending quality time with your friends and family, and also meeting and socialising with like-minded people.

Sail from port to port, stopping for lunch in beautiful bays along the way, before making the most of the afternoon breeze and sailing to your evening destination. Our flotillas are one of the most enjoyable holidays available to people looking for sailing in the sun.

# **HOW MUCH EXPERIENCE IS REQUIRED?**

A practical and positive attitude is the key! Every year we take thousands of people to the Greek Islands... many have been with us numerous times.

Several have gone on to buy their own yachts and sail to all four corners of the world!

To sail on a flotilla one member of your crew will need to hold a sailing certificate. This can be either an RYA Day Skipper Practical, an International Certificate of Competence (ICC), or an equivalent sailing certificate from another official body. Two people on board need to be aged 18 or over.

Flotilla sailing is a fantastic way for newly qualified skippers to build their experience (and sea miles) or to introduce friends and family to sailing in a gentle, stress free way.

If you don't yet have a qualification, it can take as little as six hours for experienced sailors to get their ICC in the UK. The Day Skipper Practical course, which involves more training and theory, can be done with us over a week, and what better place to do it than in the Greek Islands!


If you're not sure about which course is right for you, have a chat with our team – they can advise you on the most suitable route to getting qualified. Hiring a skipper is also an option for those who want to get a taste of flotilla life first!


### **HOW DOES A FLOTILLA WORK?**

Each flotilla of ten or eleven yachts is accompanied by a fully crewed lead yacht offering local knowledge, informative briefings, assistance and unobtrusive back-up when required. You will be shown how to work all the various aspects of the yacht including the anchor, the sails, and how to turn on the all-important engine!

We try to make your first day's sail as gentle as possible and will usually only cover 10 to 12 miles. Your lead crew will usually be at your destination before the rest of the flotilla, in order to take your lines on the quay when you arrive.







Most evenings you will be moored in a small village or town where there is a relaxed environment on shore. One evening is usually set aside for an informal pre-taverna get together.

### **OUR LEAD CREW TEAMS**

We provide each flotilla with a lead crew consisting of a skipper, hostie and engineer, who sail together on a separate yacht.

Our lead crews are chosen for their sailing and maintenance abilities, along with their gregarious nature.

The flotilla skipper has the responsibility of guiding you throughout, and will conduct daily briefings covering information about the route, weather and lunchtime anchorages.

Our 'hostie' is your link with local people and advises on nearby facilities.

The engineer ensures that jobs are dealt with quickly and the yachts remain in good working order.

Our lead crews have excellent knowledge of our sailing areas and are experienced out on the water. We also have a shore-based support team on hand to make sure everything runs smoothly.

All of our yachts are equiped with a VHF radio and you will be given a direct telephone line to your lead crew so they should always be contactable.

# **RELAXED STARTING OUT**

If you are feeling daunted by the prospect of sailing in unfamiliar waters on one of our flotillas, our lead crew will soon allay your fears.

Before setting out you will be given briefings to introduce you to the boats and get settled in to make the most of your holiday.

## YOUR FELLOW SAILORS

One of the best aspects of flotilla sailing is meeting like-minded people along the way.

These holidays are great for families, groups, couples and individual sailors. Lifelong friendships often develop on the flotillas with many returning to holiday with us.

### THE PERFECT PLACE TO LEARN TO HANDLE A YACHT

The Ionian Islands are one of the safest boating environments in the world and have provided an unbeatable training ground for sailing generally for over forty years.

During this time, we have made our yachts much easier to handle and have an unrivalled maintenance programme each winter.

# **A LITTLE ABOUT US**

From the moment you speak to one of our team on the telephone or via email you are talking to someone who has either worked on or been on the holidays. They know first-hand what the boats are like, which routes will suit you best and even what the weather might be like!

We have been running flotilla sailing holidays in the Greek Islands for nearly 50 years and, as many of you will already know, this area remains unique.

### **OUR DESTINATION**

The feeling of being there is hard to describe in print, as the sounds, smells and ambience of the islands make it a real escape from everyday life. The locals are among the most welcoming people in the world and the food is delicious.

The grilled lamb, locally caught fish, Greek salads and olive oil (not to mention the local wine) will really tickle your taste buds.

## **EASY TO SAIL YACHTS**

All our yachts are set up to be manageable by two people and, if there is no wind, there is always the engine (which fortuitously keeps the fridge cool!).

They all have easy to operate engines, electric anchor windlasses, roller furling sails, in addition to digital chart plotters for navigation, making it simple to find your way around.

Each yacht is fitted with a VHF radio for contact with the lead crew. Mobile phones are an excellent alternative method of communication, as they also keep conversations private and have infinite range.

The yachts are your accommodation, transport and entertainment for the week or fortnight. Your only additional expense is local food and drinks (and topping up your water tanks). The best bit about sailing around on one of our yachts, is that you are able to explore islands and bays off the typical tourist trail. You can visit some of the most remote, secluded and beautiful parts of the Greek Islands.

# **QUALIFICATIONS**

An ICC for sail (International Certificate of Competence), an RYA Day Skipper Practical, or other country equivalent is now required for sailing in Greece. These can be gained from most UK sailing schools throughout the year or from our own sailing school in Greece from April to November.

# OUR FLAGSHIP TWO WEEK WHOLE IONIAN FLOTILLA

> SUNDAY DEPARTURES

This one way flotilla spends two weeks meandering through the Ionian Islands from the North Ionian, to the South and vice versa. Each island and harbour has its own unique and colourful character. Most sailing days are only 12-15 miles with one or two longer days when travelling through the Lefkas Canal!

# **JOINING THE FLOTILLA**

On arrival you will be met by your lead crew and shown to your boat. The basics of your yacht will be explained before you retire to a waterside taverna for a cooling drink and a bite to eat.

### **NORTH IONIAN HIGHLIGHTS**

The flotilla will wend its way South via the alluring villages of Lakka and Gaios on Paxos Island.

A highlight of the first few days is a swim stop in Emerald Bay on Antipaxos Island. Another popular spot is Mongonisi at the southern tip of Paxos where you can Greek dance the evening away...

Historic Parga Town, with its long sandy beach and colourful promenade, is not to be missed. You may also enjoy a glorious sunset in the small town of Mourtos, or a night at anchor in Two Rock Bay.

### TRANSITING THE LEFKAS CANAL

For those of you in search of culture, the traditional Greek town of Lefkas will be of interest.

Once you have cruised through the Lefkas Canal, a swim stop at Goat Bay is highly recommended! Nearby Palairos is a charming village harbour also well known for its striking sunsets.

### **SOUTH IONIAN HIGHLIGHTS**

Once in the South Ionian, you will sail to a mixture of smaller and larger coastal villages. Along with some of the more well known spots like Fiskardo on Kefalonia Island, you may visit the picturesque harbours of Frikes on Ithaka and Sivota on Lefkas.

You could stop off on the island of Atoko if you fancy dropping the anchor and enjoying a swim in the crystal clear waters. Or you could moor in one of the smaller bays on Meganisi island.

### TYING UP FOR YOUR FINAL NIGHT WITH THE FLOTILLA

Your flotilla will finish in either our north or south lonian base (depending where you started)! It is time to enjoy one last meal with the rest of the flotilla in one of the waterside tavernas.

Visit the highlights of the Ionian Islands and enjoy sailing a few more miles

# TWO WEEK FLOTILLA SAILING HOLIDAYS AROUND THE VILLAGES OF THE ARGOLIC GULF & SARONIC ISLANDS

SUNDAY DEPARTURES

Our popular Saronic flotilla is also in an 'easy sailing area' (the Argolic Gulf). The flotilla starts and finishes in the coastal town of Astrous. You will most likely sail south-eastwards (weather dependent) to Tiros or Plaka, then on to Kiparissi where a decision will be made whether to carry on south to Monemvasia, or sail across to the beautiful island area of Spetses, Dhokos and Hydra. You may even get up to the island of Poros.

## **COAST HOPPING THE PELOPONNESE**

The towns of Tiros, Plaka and Kiparissi are all perched on the eastern Peloponnese coast. Dining on the beach in Tiros is an experience hard to beat. Plaka is a small harbour offering a peaceful spot with crystal clear waters and a great beach.

### WINE AND DINE IN MONEMVASIA

The flotilla will then sometimes sail south to visit historic but isolated leraka, the home of the amazing castle of ancient Zarax. The quiet fishing village of leraka itself is a nice contrast to towns and villages further up the coast.

Why do we love Monemvasia? Where else can you swim with turtles in the crystal clear waters of the harbour by day... and be wine tasting in the back streets of a Byzantine city by night! If you make it there, be sure to make the effort to climb to the top of the rock! Enjoy exploring the island of Spetses and the surrounding coast. The flotilla will usually spend a night at anchor at Dhokos Island to experience the spectacular sunset and sleeping under the stars.


### **RETURNING TO ASTROUS**

The last few days will be spent sailing north along the coastline of the Argolic Gulf towards historic Navplion. A long-standing favourite is Ermioni, where the flotilla will most likely moor on the south quay. The walk around the peninsula to the north quay is a pleasant way to spend an afternoon.

You may visit the cultural hub of Navplion. A town rich in Mycenaean mythology and pretty side streets. If you fancy some exercise you can attempt the climb up to the Palamidi fortress set high up on a hill over the town!

Then you will sail back across to Astrous to spend your final evening in a traditional taverna with your fellow flotilla sailors.

# OUR TWO WEEK SPORADES ISLAND FLOTILLAS - GET AWAY FROM IT ALL!

FRIDAY DEPARTURES

We run two very popular flotillas in the Sporades. The timeless recipe of gin clear water and reliable wind has proved irresistible to all who sail here. The area is wonderfully "Greek".

### **KEENER SAILORS REJOICE**

The wind in the Sporades can be a little breezier at times, so this route is aimed at our more experienced flotilla sailors. The slightly stronger winds and the flattish seas offer invigorating sailing.

# **OREI, TRIKERI CHANNEL & THE GULF OF VOLOS**

Your introduction to the Sporades Islands will begin in Orei where you will meet your lead crew. Your first night out will often be Kiriaki (where the calamari is to die for). This is a small village with an easy to access wreck for snorkelling. Children love it!

# **SKIATHOS ISLAND**

The flotilla will sail east to the beautiful anchorage of Koukounaries. You may also spend a night in Skiathos Town with its bustling backstreets and picturesque harbour.

# **SKOPELOS ISLAND & THE MAMMA MIA CHURCH**

The beaches on the south side of Skopelos have the finest white sand you will find anywhere! Another nice stop is Loutraki where you can visit the traditional hilltop village of Glossa.

The spectacular Church of St John (better known as the church featured in the Mamma Mia movie) is great to visit - the view from the top is worth the climb, although health and safety executives may experience palpitations!

## **ALONISSOS NATIONAL MARINE PARK**

Steni Vala on Alonissos island is another very popular small village. The once abandoned old town of Alonissos, high up in the hills above Patitiri, is great for intrepid explorers. Don't forget to take a wander around the excellent museum in Patitiri. The national park fee is about €6.00pp per day.

### PEACEFUL NIGHTS AT ANCHOR

The more remote islands have stunningly clear water - Kyra Panayia is one such island with its large bays, perfect for free swinging; an ideal spot for cooking onboard and sleeping under the brightest stars you will ever witness.

After two weeks of enjoyable sailing, you will savour the final day sail back to Orei to spend your last night with your fellow sailors.

# TWO WEEK SOUTH IONIAN FLOTILLAS - SELECTED DATES IN JULY, AUGUST AND SEPTEMBER

SUNDAY DEPARTURES

The popular South Ionian sailing area is home to a steep and spectacular landscape providing a mixture of both shelter and lively breezes. This flotilla consists of mostly shortish days of 10 - 12 miles, sailing from island to island allowing plenty of time for exploring bays along the way.

## JOIN THE FLOTILLA ON LEFKAS ISLAND

After being shown your boat and meeting your lead crew, you will have the evening to relax and unwind before your first day out on the water.

The following morning, you will have a briefing with your crew who will talk you through what you can expect from your fortnight on the water. They will also let you know your first destination.

### **EXPLORING MEGANISI ISLAND**

One highlight is picturesque Spartahori Village, perched on the cliffs of Meganisi Island. You may also spend a night moored at Little Vathy.

### **SOUTHERN LEFKAS ISLAND**

Vasiliki is a popular overnight stop with great tavernas, shops and a beach. You can simply relax and watch the boats coming and going in the harbour or wander around the town.

# **ESCAPE TO KASTOS AND KALAMOS ISLANDS**

Two of our favourite island villages are Kastos and Kalamos. Tree covered and steep, Kalamos is quite a spectacular island. These traditional islands have idyllic harbours and the views are outstanding. On 6th July 2025, this flotilla will even visit Zakynthos.

### VISITING ITHAKA ISLAND

Popular Kioni and Frikes, on the east coast of Ithaka Island, are quaint villages in which you can relax. Port Vathi has become a flotilla favourite and Pere Pigadhi offers an unbeatable swim stop.

### **KEFALONIA ISLAND**

You will have the opportunity to visit some of our favourite places, such as Fiskardo, Poros, Sami and Ay Euphemia. The afternoon breezes, which funnel down the channel between Kefalonia and Ithaka, make for an invigorating sail!

### **RETURNING TO BASE**

On your last day you will return to our yacht base, here you can spend the evening reminiscing on your fortnight with your fellow flotilla sailors.



# TWO WEEK FARAWAY ISLANDS FLOTILLAS - 22ND JUNE, 27TH JULY & 24TH AUGUST

→ SUNDAY DEPARTURES



New harbours on Ericousa and Othoni, and a revamped harbour in Mathraki, prompted a return to the Faraway Islands

in 2019. The route was so popular we are returning again on selected dates!

In reality, the "Faraway Islands" really aren't all that far away. They are named this as they are Greece's furthest away islands from Athens! (Like Lands End in the UK or Finisterre in Spain.)

# YOUR FIRST FEW DAYS EXPLORING THE FARAWAYS

Most of the time, you will head north in the first few days to the sparsely populated Faraways.

Ericousa has a large bay, great for free swinging or anchoring off at night. An excellent new harbour has been built on Ericousa too, which is safe from all directions.

Not many yachts venture north of Corfu so this area is quite special. Nights under the incredibly vibrant stars can be almost as light as daytime.

Othoni is clad in a thick cover of pine and olive trees with rocky scrub on the hilltops looking out over the sea to Mathraki and other smaller islands.

All three of the islands feature beautiful sandy beaches. Some flotillas may spend a night at anchor in Port Timoni and a night in spectacular Paleokastritsa. They are sheltered from the prevailing wind and visits to them will depend on the forecast winds.

The flotilla will then head for Paxos, either using the "inside route" (the east coast of Corfu) or the "outside route" (the west coast of Corfu).

If it goes on the inside route the flotilla may call into historic Corfu Town. This gives everyone an opportunity to immerse themselves in Venetian and Greek history. It has a unique atmosphere.

Paxos never fails to provide wonderful memories, with the beautiful bay of Lakka and the Greek dancing nights of Mongonisi - to name just a couple.

## MEANDERING BACK TO THE MAINLAND

On your way back to base, you may spend a few nights in Sivota Mourtos, Iggy Creek and Sayaidha. Other harbours you are likely to visit on your route are the picturesque villages of Kassiopi and St Stephanos, located on the north-east coast of Corfu. Both are really atmospheric places to be, with a feeling of being in the 'real Greece'.

# ONE WEEK 'END OF SEASON' PAXOS & CORFU FLOTILLA PLUS A WHOLE IONIAN DELIVERY FLOTILLA

As all the yachts from the flotillas assemble in the Corfu area in time for the school half term holiday at the end of the summer season, we run special one week half term flotillas.

The flotillas are divided into family groups, according to children's ages.

Couples and other adults are concentrated on separate flotillas. Teachers rejoice!



# MEETING YOUR FLOTILLA IN SIVOTA VILLAGE

Your starting point will be on Lefkas Island in Sivota Village. This flotilla will essentially sail where the wind takes it. With a myriad of harbours, bays and villages to choose from, your week will be spent island hopping around this beautiful sailing area.

Your lead crew will plan a route with a mixture of bustling towns, traditional villages and relaxed bays (and hopefully some exciting sailing thrown in as well).

### THE SOUTH IONIAN IS YOUR OYSTER

To name just a few of the islands in this area: Kefalonia, Ithaka, Kalamos, Kastos and Meganisi are some of the islands which are likely to be on your itinerary.

Ithaka is the place to go for small harbours and traditional waterside tavernas. A stop in one of the East coast bays can be idyllic for a swim. The main town of Ithaka, 'Big Vathi', is a flotilla favourite.

Kefalonia Island is famed for the port of Fiskardo, however there are several other ports and lots of bays to drop the hook for a swim.

To the East is Atoko Island which is an ideal spot to cool off at anchor while waiting for the afternoon breeze!

### THE EASTERN MOST ISLANDS

Two favourite stops are the villages of Kastos and Kalamos. Both of these traditional Greek islands have idyllic harbours, where the locals warmly welcome visitors.

The island of Meganisi is comprised of so many inlets and bays that you'll be spoilt for choice. There are several delightful harbours including 'Little Vathi', Spartahori and Port Atheni, along with a selection of glorious anchorages.

You will probably finish your week with a fantastic sail tacking up or down the Meganisi channel before tying up at our yacht base. Your final night will be spent enjoying a meal in a waterside taverna.

# **SETTING SAIL FOR PAXOS ISLAND**

Your first day out will usually be a short hop to the waterside town of Sivota Mourtos. The next morning you will likely set off westwards to Paxos.

Paxos is, of course, the highlight of this flotilla cruise with its four beautiful harbours - Lakka, Longos, Gaios and Mongonisi.

Gaios is a traditional Greek town, with tavernas and shops to explore. Lakka is a laid back village in a large bay famed for its emerald waters.

### **GREEK DANCING THE NIGHT AWAY**

Mongonisi is another fantastic stop on the south east coast of the island of Paxos.

You can swim off the back of your boat, siesta in the afternoon and then spend the evening dining and Greek dancing with the rest of the flotilla. The family who own the taverna put on a great show and then afterwards it is your turn!

A highlight of this flotilla is a morning spent in Vromi Bay (Emerald Bay) on Antipaxos Island. Enjoy a lazy lunch and swim before the afternoon breeze arrives and you can savour a great sail back to Paxos. For the more adventurous sailors among you, a sail down the west coast of Paxos, exploring its spectacular cliffs and caves, is a glorious way to spend a day.

## **EXPLORING THE HISTORIC STREETS OF PARGA**

This flotilla normally stops for a night in the picture postcard coastal town of Parga on the mainland. The mooring at Valtos Beach will make you impatient to jump in the water. Wandering around Parga town in the evening is a very special experience!

The flotilla will essentially go where the wind blows, so there will be variations of this route to make the sailing as comfortable as possible. Another possible stop is the fishing village of Petriti on the south east coast of Corfu Island.

Finally we return to our base, where you can spend your final night relaxing and sharing tales of the week's events with your fellow sailors.

Our yachts are wintered in Gouvia Marina, on Corfu Island, where they receive comprehensive maintenance and cosmetic attention. At the end of April/beginning of May, all yachts are sailed to their summer bases in the Ionian, the Saronic, and to the Sporades.

During October, they are sailed back to Gouvia Marina. These trips are known as 'delivery' cruises.

It is normally our more practical and experienced flotilla sailors who take part. Any teething issues with the yachts tend to become apparent in the first few weeks as the yachts set sail for the first time in the year. Keener sailors enjoy these cruises as they cover longer daily distances.

After possible visits to Aegina or Agistri islands your cruise will conclude in Epidavros.

# • Three Week Corfu - Sporades Islands (and vice versa)

For those with a little more time on their hands... It will leave Corfu in April/May and head south through the Ionian Islands before coming round into the Gulf of Patras. Then the flotillas will turn eastwards through the Corinth Canal and the Saronic Gulf before heading North between the mainland of Greece and Evia, passing through the famous old bridge at Chalkida. Finally, the journey will end in Orei on the island of Evia (vice versa in October). There is never a dull moment!

The flotilla might call into places such as Poros, Epidavros (for a quick look at the amphitheatre) and the Island of Aegina.

You will be passing through the newly revamped Corinth Canal and into the Gulf of Corinth. Depending on which way the wind is blowing, your next highlights are likely to be Galaxidi, the Island of Trizonia and passing under the incredible Anti Rion bridge.

The passage through the Gulf of Patras and the Gulf of Corinth takes us all on a trip through history and mythology. It will also provide time for a visit to the incredible centre of the ancient world at Delphi. From there, you will enter the South Ionian, taking in both familiar and unfamiliar stops along the way.

Messolonghi is a quite different type of town and the harbour is a turtle breeding ground. We discovered a beautiful new spot called Antikyra in 2024, so there remains a little bit of an exploratory aspect to these cruises.

This is an opportunity to expand your sailing horizons during the longest sunny days of the year! If you have enjoyed all our flotillas this may top them all! It will be more of a sailing adventure in warm waters with spectacular scenery. Delivery dates:

# SET SAIL FOR THREE WEEKS OF CRUISING

This route has been designed to venture to some of the lesser-known village harbours of the Ionian Islands. Many of you may have already sailed our flagship Whole Ionian flotilla before; imagine the freedom of an extra week on top of this already amazing fortnight!

Your cruise will cast off from Plataria on the mainland and initially head north, visiting several atmospheric towns and villages including Venetian Corfu Town, and usually the Faraway Islands.

Making the most of the regular afternoon breezes in the Corfu channel, you will spend a few days in the harbours of Sayiadha on the mainland, as well as Kassiopi and St Stephanos on the north-east coast of Corfu Island. You are likely to call into Paxos and Anti-Paxos to visit Mongonisi, Gaios or Lakka.

Over on the mainland, the flotilla may spend a night at anchor in the secluded Two Rock Bay before heading south.

You may now start venturing further off the flotilla trail into the Gulf of Amvrakia. This is an inland sea and is the best area for wildlife spotting. The shallow waters create the perfect environment for huge pelicans, dolphins and turtles. Keep your eyes peeled!

# Late May and Early June Three weeks of relaxation!



The flotilla will travel through the Lefkas Canal into the South Ionian. Here you will island hop between Lefkas, Meganisi, Kefalonia, Ithaka, Kalamos and Kastos. Your lead crew will keep an eye on the local weather forecast and your itinerary will alter accordingly. You will essentially sail where the wind takes you!

On the way back north again you may spend a night in traditional Lefkas town or one of many other possible harbours.

This flotilla is the perfect way to really relax into the flotilla way of life whilst visiting some new towns and villages along the way!



Many people enjoy going on our flotillas by themselves or as couples. Some have their first sailing experience on a skippered 'Share-a-Yacht' and come again, year after year. Gone but not forgotten are our amazing 'Pot Luck Flotilla' years before certification requirements! Things have changed over the years in that, for our 'traditional Share-a-Yacht' without a skipper, all yacht crew must have a sailing certificate.

The luxury skippered version of our traditional 'Share-a-Yacht' programme allows individual sailors with no qualifications to book their own ensuite cabin. For this option, an onboard skipper is provided (this is why it costs a bit more).

Sailors with a range of experience levels take part. If you have never sailed but would like to, then you can take the skippered share-a-yacht option to learn the ropes.

This is an excellent starting point before taking on the course to gain the qualification required to skipper a yacht yourself. Share-a-yachts are an opportunity to make new friends whilst sailing in the sun.

We find it's better that people meet at the beginning of the holiday and not before, as everybody is in the holiday mood by then.

There is no smoking allowed anywhere on our yachts, inside or outside.

We have even had a few Share-a-Yacht weddings over the years! No promises, but you have to try very hard to not enjoy sailing in the Greek Islands!

All 36ft Beneteaus have three double cabins plus a berth in the saloon, so they are comfortable. Having a maximum of three people per yacht works best as it allows a separate sleeping area for everyone aboard (Beneteau 361 - page 46).

This keeps things relaxed and comfortable for everybody. This option is available on our 1 Week flotilla share-a-yacht boats. Our lead crews reserve the right to "cast any disruptive individuals adrift" if they feel that the safety or happiness of the yacht or flotilla is being affected.




#### **RELAX IN THE SALVATOR SPA**

Hiring a car opens up the possibility of exploring the amazing villages and towns on the mainland surrounding Paraa itself.

If you choose not to hire a car, Lichnos Beach is within walking distance. Beautiful Valtos Beach is just the other side of historic Parga Town (there is a free shuttle to Parga). There are a number of tavernas in Parga Town and nearby villages.










A 10 minute drive north-west will find you at Ali Pasha's castle. The views over the Ionian Sea are incredible and plenty of the original fortifications remain in place.
